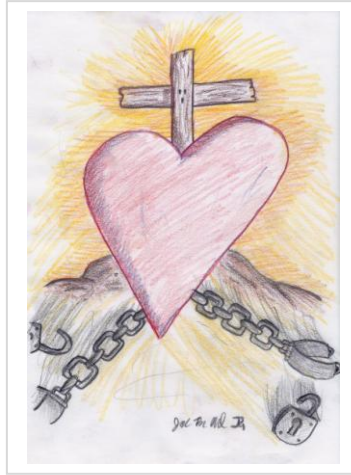


Greg & Wendy Meisel

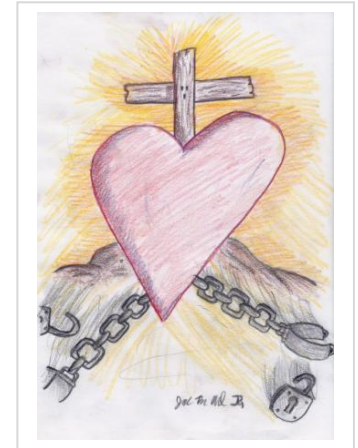

Counseling Philosophy

Caring for the Heart New England is committed to assist individuals, couples, and families to find freedom from emotional issues, spiritual problems and spiritual strongholds.

We depend upon the Holy Spirit to lead the counselor in assisting the counselee to resolve each of their problems. The Holy Spirit must direct, convict, and enable the counselee in this process.

We apply Biblical principles in leading a person to find freedom from each problem. We do not judge, but seek to lead individuals to freedom. This freedom will result in their experiencing God's purpose, fulfillment, joy, and peace in relationship with Him and others. (Gal. 5:1; John 10:10) Jesus focused on the heart to resolve spiritual and emotional issues. Our counselors accept, understand, and care for the needs of each person's heart. Freedom comes as issues are dealt with at the heart level.
